High schools in central and southern Illinois are eligible to enter student artwork in one of the largest high school competitions associated with a profession art fair.

REQUIRMENTS FOR ENTRY:

- 1. Students must be enrolled in high school and age 19 or under.
- 2. Two-dimensional pieces must be framed under glass or Plexiglas with wire suitable for hanging, or matted and framed using Swiss Clips and Plexiglas with wire suitable for hanging. Swiss Clips are available at most art or frame stores. Weak or dangerous hanging devices will disqualify the artwork. Canvases should have painted edges or simple frames.
- 3. Wet artwork will not be hung and will be disqualified.
- The student may complete the Lindenwood application for admissions form found on their web site http://belleville/lindenwood.edu if interested. Questions about Lindenwood should be directed to Ms. Reeta Piirala-Skoglund at 618-239-6242
- 5. Two-dimensional pieces including framing must be no larger than 36" X 40". Three-dimensional pieces must be stable and weigh less than 50 lbs.
- 6. Three-dimensional pieces that are hung must fit two-dimensional size and not weigh more than five pounds.
- 7. Student name, title, media, size, school, and student phone number **must** be attached to the back of each piece of art (see form on application).

- 8. NO ENTRY MAY BE CHANGED AFTER MAY 1.
- 9. This is a family event and images should be suitable for the general public. Art on the Square reserves the right to remove objectionable images.
- 10. Make sure all work meets the requirements of the competition.
- 11. <u>Incomplete or illegible entry forms will disqualify the artwork from entry and hanging.</u>
 Please fill out entry forms neatly and completely.
- 12. Copying of someone else's artwork will disqualify the entry.
- 13. Entry forms must be completed neatly and mailed or delivered to be received by May 1 to:

- 18. For the sake of the show, please do not remove artwork before 4 pm. on Sunday.

- 1). Entries are limited to 25 per teacher.
- 2). Entries cannot be changed after May 1.
- 3). We need <u>signature releases</u> and <u>initials</u> on the entry form, from the students, for themselves and their art work; from parents for the student; and from you the teacher, to be able to enter and so we can put pictures of the winners and their teachers on the Art on the Square website and publications.
- 4). At the awards ceremony we ask that the teachers accompany the winning student on stage to accept their award and for a photo opportunity. We know how much an art teacher contributes to the success of their students and would like to honor the teachers also.

Teachers should help their students COMPLETELY and NEATLY fill out the application form. Labels, awards, publicity, etc. will be made from the application. Please check that hanging devises are workable and well attached. We cannot be responsible for damaged artwork because of poor framing or hanging devices.
